## PROFESSIONALS WHO MUST INCLUDE A LICENSE NUMBER IN ADS

- Residential Builders and Maintenance and Alteration Contractors: A licensee **shall** include the name, <u>license number</u>, and actual business address, as shown on the license, **in all advertising**. The use of a telephone or post office box number alone is prohibited. When sales of new homes are being made by a licensed builder, through a licensed real estate broker, advertisements may indicate the broker's name <u>or</u> both the names of the builder and broker. **Mich Admin Code R 338.1532(1)** 
  - Basically, Residential Builders are licensed to build a new home from the ground up and do repairs.
  - o Maintenance & Alterations Contractors are licensed to perform specific trades only.\* The trades, or crafts for a maintenance & alteration contractor are:
    - carpentry (A)
    - concrete (B)
    - excavation (D)
    - insulation work(G)
    - masonry (I)
    - siding (K)
    - roofing (M)
    - screens and storm sash (N)
    - gutters (O)
    - tile & marble (P)
    - house wrecking (R)
    - swimming pools (S)
    - basement waterproofing (T)

Although these types of contractors are the only ones *mandated* by the rules to provide the identifying information, we suggest that you have a policy of requiring this information for others that the general public might consider "contractors."

• <u>Dentists:</u> A dentist who is licensed as a specialist **shall** include his or her <u>license number</u> in **all public advertisements for that specialty**, including, but not limited to, telephone books, solicitations, print media, newspapers, and internet advertising. **Mich Admin Code** R 338.11525(2)

<sup>\*</sup>Michigan law was recently amended in March 2019 to remove painting and decorating from the list of trades covered by a state license for residential maintenance and alteration.

## PROFESSIONALS WHO DON'T NEED TO INCLUDE A LICENSE NUMBER

- <u>Real Estate Appraisers:</u> A licensee shall place his or her <u>license number</u> and license level on all reports and shall produce evidence of licensing upon request by a member of the public or a representative of the department. A <u>license number</u> shall **not** be required in advertising material. **Mich Admin Code R 339.23405(2)**
- ALL OTHER PROFESSIONALS? No mention of advertising found in regs.
